Reading

Last week some of you may have spoken to the class teacher about reading at home and how we are currently monitoring this in school. You will be aware that our lovely librarian, Mrs West, has worked really hard in the library and in creating our amazing rewards systems for gaining a treat in the wishing jar and the vending machine. For most children the points they gain will come directly from our Accelerated Reader program, but for those who are not yet on the program we are awarding points according to the number of times they read at home. Therefore, please let us know you have heard your child read, or read to them as in this case, a signature earns a point and points mean prizes!!!



Children who read **1,000,000 words** a year are in the top 2% of reading achievement.

When children have a home library, as little as **20 books** of their own, they achieve **3 more years** of schooling than children who don't have any books at home.

Read **20 minutes** a day and you'll read **1,800,000 words** per year.

We are currently aiming to hold a live performance of the Nativity on December 2nd. This will be reviewed under the current circumstances; however, the plan is for it to ahead and everyone is welcome to attend with guests.
